Just a few weeks ago Centenary received the CO (Certificate of Occupancy) for our newly renovated spaces. Since then your children's ministry team has been working diligently to get furniture, toys, and supplies out of the storage places they have been tucked into for the last 2 years and into the 3 floors of the newly renovated East building! We are working towards a phased opening of COVID-Safe in-person children's ministry. The first phase of this plan will be opening up the nurseries for infants through pre-kindergarteners during Sunday morning worship. As we hire new staff and train returning staff on new procedures in addition to making sure all of our new check-in systems work safely we are working towards being able to open the nurseries sometime in mid-late May. You will be hearing much more about this as plans and details continue to fall into place. We can't wait to share this amazing new space with you, but in the meantime we appreciate your patience!
